<u>SPRING FEASTS - JESUS 1ST COMING - FULFILLED:</u>			
PASSOVER (14 th of Nisan) Lev. 23:5	Kill lamb; apply blood on doorpost (Ex. 12:6, 7) Redemption of children of Israel from bondage	Crucifixion of Messiah Jesus (I Cor. 5:7 - Messiah our Passover)	Redemption; freedom from bondage of sin FOREVER! Justification – declared righteous (II Cor. 5:21)
UNLEAVENED BREAD (15 th of Nisan) Lev. 23:6-8	Purging of leaven (sin) (Ex. 12:15). Left Egypt for Promised Land (Ex. 12:31-39). Separation from the world	Burial of Jesus (Matt. 27:57)	Dying to self Gal. 2:20 Sanctification (Phil. 1:6)
FIRSTFRUITS (day after Sabbath) Lev. 23:9-14 Deut. 26:1-20	Barley harvest – promise of harvest to come	Jesus' resurrection (I Cor. 15:20-23 - Messiah our firstfruits)	Believers' resurrection Glorification (I Cor. 15:50-56)
SHAVUOT PENTECOST (50 days after First Fruits) Lev. 23:15-21	Tradition-giving of the Law “about 3,000” died (Ex. 32:28)	Giving of the Holy Spirit “about 3,000” given eternal life (Acts 2:41)	Birth of the Church Jew & Gentile – fellow heirs (Eph. 3:6)
<u>FALL FEASTS - JESUS 2ND COMING - YET TO BE FULFILLED:</u>			
TRUMPETS (Rosh Hashanah) (1 st of Tishri) Lev. 23:23-25	Trumpets blown – gathering for judgment (observed in traditional Judaism today)	Tribulation – regathering of Israel (Jer. 32:37-41)	Judgment/purging (Eze. 20:33-34; Eze. 22:17-22); repentance (Hos. 5:15)
YOM KIPPUR (Day of Atonement) (10 th of Tishri) Lev. 23:26-32	Yearly atonement (Lev. 16)	Jesus' Second Coming following Israel's repentance (Zech. 12:10)	Restoration (Isa. 62:4-5)
TABERNACLES (15 th of Tishri) Lev. 23:33-44	God's provision & shelter: God's desire to tabernacle w/ man (Ex. 25:8)	Millennial Kingdom (Zech. 14:16-19) Rev. 21:1-3 – the tabernacle of God is w/ men	Rejoicing (Isa. 65:18-19)
