Observations:
What led up to "the fullness of the time"?
The typical
No Davidic King.

Matt. 1 – In Jesus' genealogy through Joseph in Matthew 1 we see a roadblock within the line of David re: the kingship.

Re: Jeconiah, aka Coniah - Jer. 22:24-30...GOD said, Write this man down as childless, a man who shall not prosper in his days; for none of his descendants shall prosper, sitting on the throne of David, and ruling anymore in Judah.

What about II Sam. 7:12-16???

Jer. 23:5-6 – the BRANCH!

How can Jesus be King of Kings in the future?

Matt. 1:16 - Mary, of whom was born Jesus who is called Messiah - "of whom" is in the singular. Not pertaining to Mary and Joseph!!! And then we read in Matt. 1:18 - Mary conceived by the Holy Spirit - a virgin birth!!!!
